POSITION

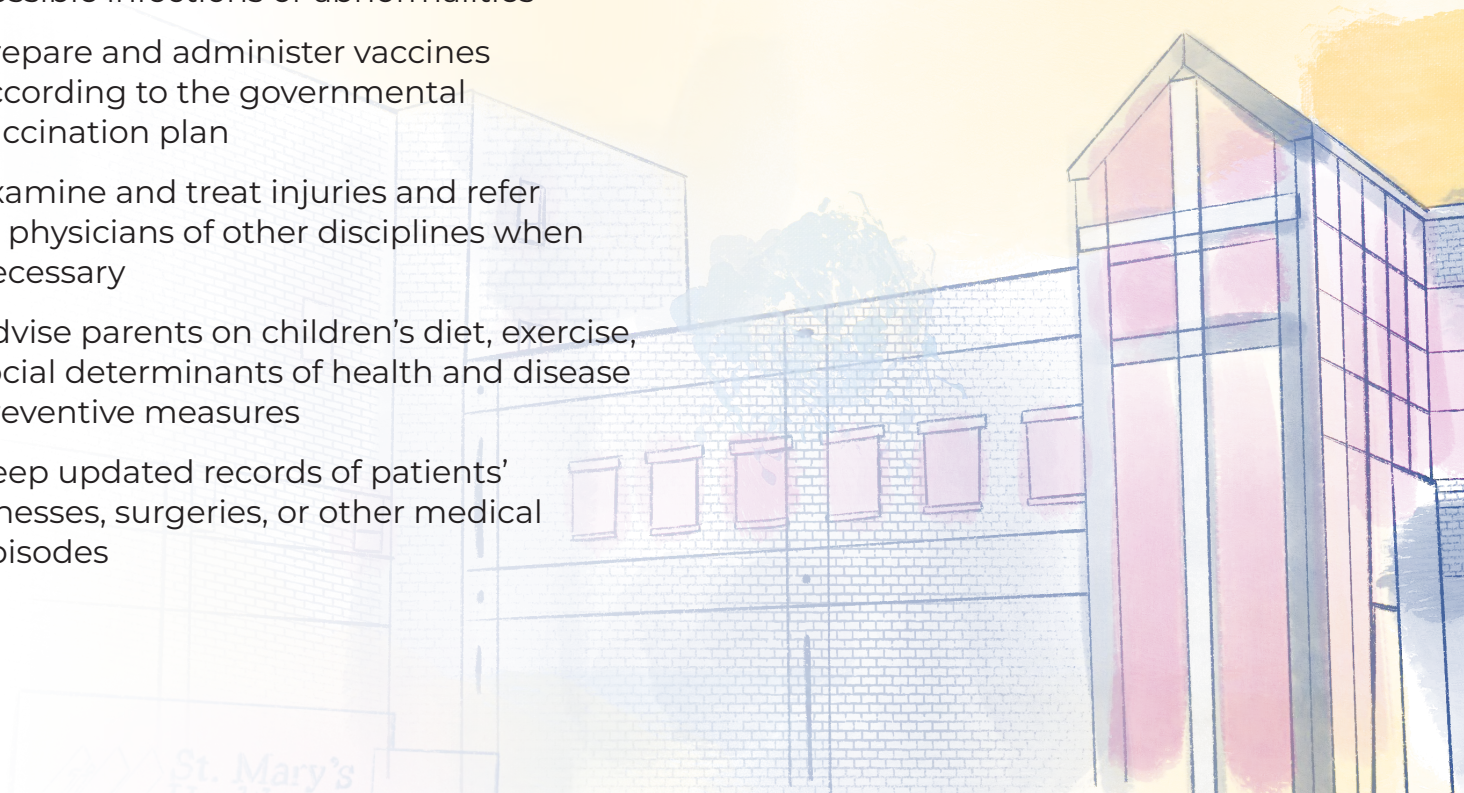
St. Mary's is seeking a board certified/board eligible Pediatrician to join our primary care team.
